The Project

On February 28, 1993 Hunger Project: Run Across America began at the U.S. Capitol building in Washington D.C. The focus of this project was to increase the awareness of hunger, homelessness and poverty issues, encourage youth and community initiatives and disseminate the booklet "How to Help Hunger and Homelessness in America". Across the United States, the project received proclamations and resolutions in the major cities and extensive local support of this educational event. On July 15, 1993, the team reached their final destination of San Francisco, California. Here, they were greeted by representatives from the White House and Congress at the U.S. Conference of Mayor's meeting of the Task Force on Hunger and Homelessness.

In response to the vast need and severity of these problems across the United States, Phase II was developed and entitled Project: Focus On America.
